DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Individualize the content when necessary to meet each student's learning needs.
- Provide interventions (Reading, Reading comprehension, Writing, and Math) to students who have specific needs in a one-on-one or small group in the least restrictive environment.
- Collaborate with homeroom teachers in the classroom.
- Communicates effectively and efficiently with students, parents, and colleagues.
- Provide accommodations and modifications.
- Create and implement ILPs and Accommodation plans.
- Meets with outside specialists attending to students' needs.
- Review ILPs and meet with parents.
- Meet with parents to talk about their children's academic progress.
- Works in conjunction with the Child Study Team (CST) to recommend psychoeducational evaluators, etc.
- Adheres to strict student confidentiality.
- Referred students for outside services or evaluations.
- Monitor student's progress and provide feedback on specific goals.
- Update student's goals and information in the ILP.
- Pre-teach and re-teach in small groups or one-on-one based on students' needs.
